Christine Elaine Brown, 72, passed away after a 10 year battle with Parkinson's Disease at her home March 27, 2024 in Pueblo West Colorado. She and Roger were married August 2, 1973 in Colorado Springs. They spent their first 10 years together in Colorado City and then in Pueblo before moving to Pueblo West in 1998. She taught private piano and guitar lessons for many years in student homes and in her studio and served many years in churches in the Greenhorn Valley area, Pueblo and Pueblo West in the music and media ministries. In recent years she joined her husband as a Life Member of the Pueblo Weisbrod Aircraft Museum as a volunteer. Chris leaves an emptiness in the hearts of her family and friends but her memory will live on in their hearts. At her request cremation has taken place.
