Jimmie Earl Steenbergen of Pueblo West, CO passed away peacefully on April 29, 2024, surrounded by his wife and three children. Jimmie was born in Lucas, KY on April 26, 1937, to Dennis and Willie Neal (Britt) Steenbergen. He grew up in Lexington, IL with his sister Virginia. In 1955, Jimmie joined the United States Navy and was forever proud of his military service. On November 24, 1960, Jimmie married the love of his life, Carrol. Jimmie and Carrol raised their 3 kids; Lisa, Laura, and Kevin in East Peoria, IL but spent many weekends and holidays back in Lexington with family. Jimmie spent some time as a reserve Deputy Sheriff with Tazewell County Sheriff's Department and he dabbled in politics by spending four years on the East Peoria City Council. Jimmie was a Deacon in the East Peoria Church of Christ. Jimmie retired as a Nursing Home Administrator, a job that seemed to fit his personality perfectly. He loved people and had a gift for making others smile; Jimmie could make friends wherever he went. After spending most of their lives in Central IL, Jimmie and Carrol retired and moved to Pueblo West, CO in 2008, just three doors down from their son Kevin. Jimmie was preceded in death by both of his parents and is survived by his wife Carrol, his children Lisa (Richard) Wells of Abilene, TX, Laura Palmer of Canton, OH and his son Kevin (Karen) Steenbergen of Pueblo West, CO. His grandchildren also survive him; Jason and Joshua Wells, Andrew, David, and Jordan Palmer as well as Kody, Dennis, and Sarah Steenbergen. Jimmie also had five great grandchildren; Colton, Kaitlynn, Ryan, Madelyn and Lillian. Jimmie will be interred at the Pikes Peak National Cemetery in Colorado Springs, CO. Services will be at 2:30PM on Thursday, May 9, 2024, at the Southwest Church of Christ in Pueblo, CO. Jimmie loved animals and dogs in particular.
