On January 29th Sherry A. Higgins, 74, passed away at her home in Pueblo West, Colorado after a long illness. She was born at St. Francis Hospital in Santa Barbara to Bob and Helen Overall. Sherry attended the one room school at Paradise Camp, and graduated from San Marcos High School in Santa Barbara. She was a California girl and loved the ocean and the beach. As a young woman, Sherry worked as a server in the Biltmore Hotel in Santa Barbara and spoke of meeting Hollywood movie stars. She moved to Colorado and worked at the Redstone Inn high in the Colorado Mountains and then at the Carbondale Middle School kitchen, where she enjoyed serving the children and working with a great team of women. In Redstone, she met her partner and husband of 40 years, Daniel Higgins. Dan and Sherry later moved to the prairie, settling in Pueblo West where Sherry began her 20 year career with Home Depot. Sherry loved water, the ocean, the lake and rivers. She was a dedicated lap swimmer. Sherry and Dan had many adventures in this great country, sometimes traveling on horseback into the Rocky Mountain wilderness. They loved returning to Santa Barbara and driving Hwy 1. She and Dan traveled nearly all of Colorado's Scenic Byways looking for fall colors and Colorado wildlife. Sherry is predeceased by her parents Bob Overall and Helen Overall and sister Mary Jane Overall. She is survived by her husband

Daniel and brother Robert Overall as well as her beloved extended family and her community of friends who were touched by her beautiful soul. Dan and Sherry are grateful for the support of our wonderful neighbors and the compassionate care and support from Gentiva during Sherry's final months.
